

### Mathematics

The children will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. We will develop their understanding of the composition of numbers to 10. We will create repeating patterns.

### Communication and Language

Listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding.

Share non-fiction books to develop a deep familiarity with new knowledge and vocabulary.

We really value the importance of talk and community so would love to encourage more talking at home about what the children have been learning at school.

Each week, on Google Classroom, we will send home prompt questions, videos or pictures to encourage this.

### Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore with musical instruments and how they are grouped in different families.

We will continue to get crafty whilst working on our cutting skills, and creating a class collaborative piece.

### Personal Social Emotional Development

The children will be working on identifying and moderating their own feelings and thinking about the perspective of others. We will also have class discussions based on how to look after the world around us

We will be working to support the children with their transition into Year 1, with secret missions. We will discuss the feelings of feeling nervous but also excited!

Stunning start – BUGS! We will hunt for minibeasts and record what we find.

Fabulous Finish – Our class assembly sharing our learning!

### Physical Development

In PE we are focusing on small team games, encouraging the children to run skilfully and negotiate space safely, avoiding obstacles and taking turns. We will continue to help the children develop their pencil grip and develop their letter formation. PE will remain on a Wednesday.

### Understanding the World

We will be learning about the world around us.

We will be learning how to take care of our environment and look after our surroundings.

We will continue to explore the outdoors in specific outdoor learning lessons, led by Mrs Lochwood every Friday.

### How can I help my child?
