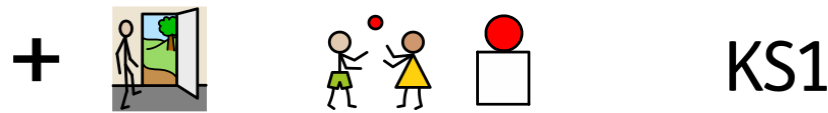
I will walk into school across the Key Stage one playground



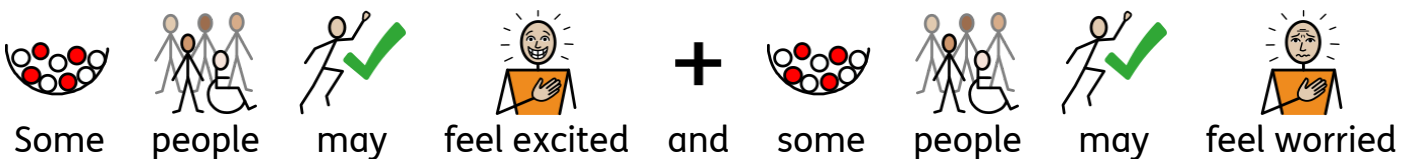
and in through the door.
