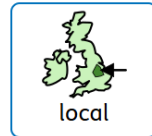
Learning Experience Key vocabulary

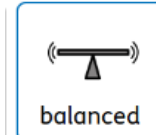
Lake: A large area of water surrounded by land.

Balanced: Even or having the right amount of things.



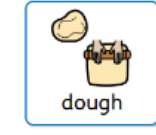

CAD – Computer Aided Design: Using a computer to create designs.



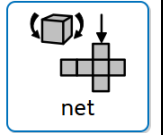

net

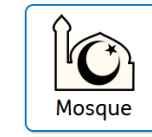
Template: A pattern used to help make something.

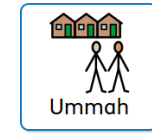

Mosque: A place where Muslims pray.



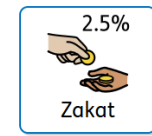

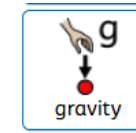
Zakat (charity): Giving to people in need.

Gravity: A force that pulls things towards the Earth.



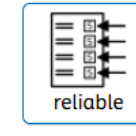
