### Glossary of Key vocabulary

Feelings are what we feel inside our bodies.

The Zones of Regulation are different "zones" or "colours" that show how we're feeling. Each color helps us know what we're feeling and what we can do to feel better.

Coordination means using your body parts together to do something smoothly.

Control is being able to move your body or an object in the way you want.

When you move **high**, it means you're going up!

			<p>When you move <b>low</b>, it means you're going down!</p> <p>Moving <b>fast</b> means going quickly! It's when you run, jump, or do something really quickly.</p> <p>Moving <b>slow</b> means going slowly, taking your time. It's like moving in a calm, steady way.</p>
