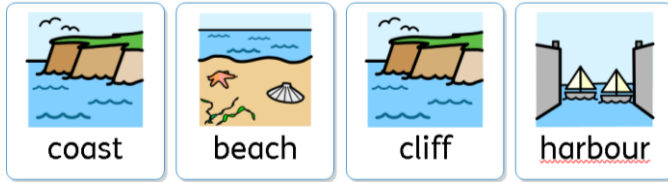




Year 2 Summer Term 2

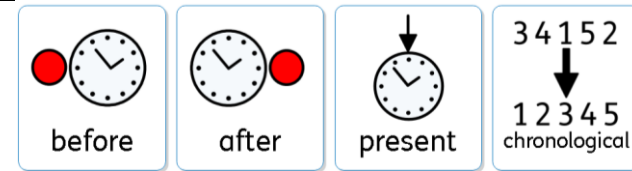
Geography

Harbour – a place for ships to moor.



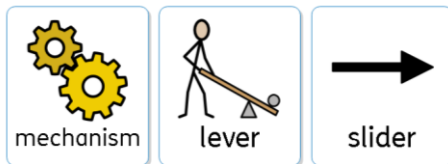
History

Lever - something used to move something up and down.

Slider – something used to move something left to right.



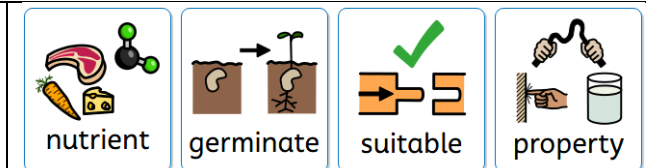
Art
