



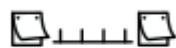

influence

- the capacity to have an effect on the character, development, or behaviour of someone or something, or the effect itself.

- a person's opinion / way of thinking about (or looking at) something.

industrial revolution

- a period of major technological change / mechanisation (between 1750 and 1900).



workhouse

- a place that gave housing and work to people who had nowhere else to go.



mechanisation

- the introduction of machines or automatic devices into a process, activity, or place.

- the action or fact of treating someone unfairly in order to benefit from their work.
