#### Science



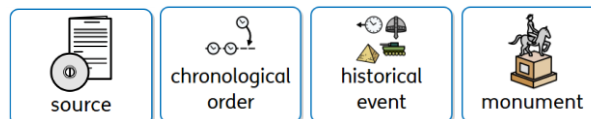
**Diagram** – a scientific picture to show how something happens

**Germinate** – the process of a seed turning into a plant

#### History



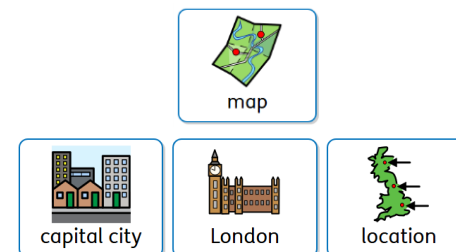
**Chronological order** – in order of when events happened

**Map** – a document that shows where places are

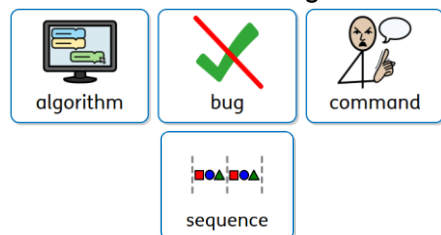
**London** – the capital city of England

##### Gymnastics

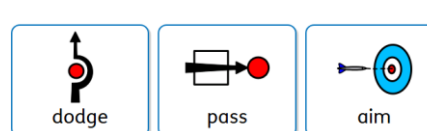


**Balance** – an even distribution of weight
