




Year 5 Spring Term 1

Gravity

The force that pulls things down to the ground.



Friction

When surfaces rub together and slow things down.




Mechanism

A set of parts that work together to make something move.



Lever

A stiff bar that helps lift or move things.



Pulley


A wheel with a rope that helps lift or pull things.



Gear

A toothed wheel that works with other gears to make things move.

Design & Technology




Product

Something that is made to use or sell.




Sketch

A quick, simple drawing of an idea.




Diagram

A drawing that shows how something works.




Label

Pattern


A shape or plan used to make something.

Music




Chord

When you play several notes at the same time.




Melody

A series of notes that make a tune.



Notation

Symbols that show music on paper.



Notes

Symbols that tell you which sounds to play or sing.



Percussion

Instruments you hit, shake, or tap to make sounds.



Projection

Making your sound loud so everyone can hear it.
