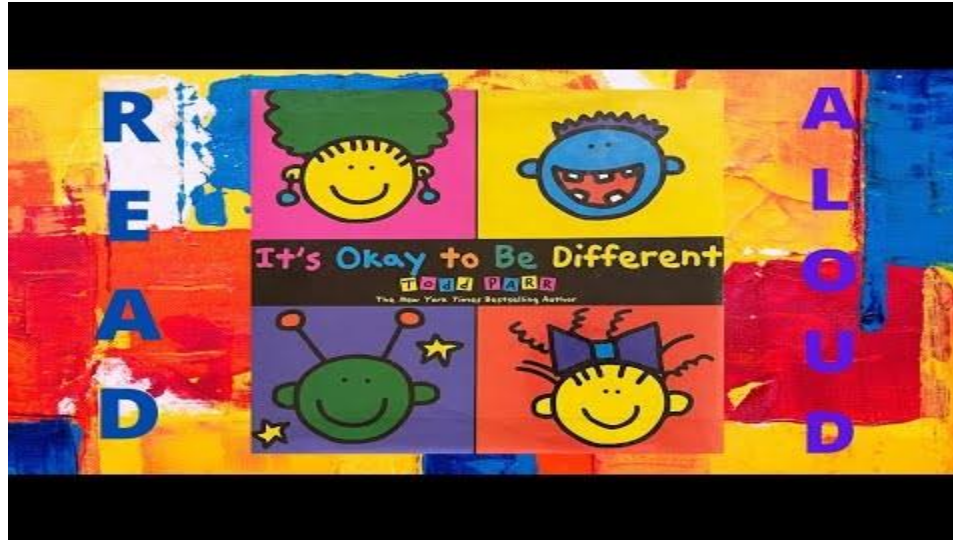


What Can We Do?
