P.E. Kit	Shorts – navy blue or black PE t shirt – white Trainers (for outside wear which do not extend above the ankle) Plain tracksuit bottoms – navy blue (for outside PE sessions) School logo jumper/cardigan
Outdoor Learning Clothes	Clothes which you don't mind getting dirty. These will be weather dependent but may include tracksuit bottoms, T-shirt and jumper, layers may be required if really cold Waterproof coat Wellingtons or shoes which can get muddy
Clubs	Additional items of clothing may be needed to take part in some after school sporting activities:- Football – boots, shin pads, mouth guards (optional) Rugby – boots, mouth guards Environmental – Wellingtons, tracksuits bottoms

All clothing, including jackets, MUST be clearly named

In hot weather please ensure you send your child in to school with plenty of sun cream applied (preferably no lower than factor 15), a sun hat and a water bottle which your child can refill throughout the day.

An old shirt or apron for art and craft would also be helpful. It can be kept in their PE bag so it is always available. It could save you a fortune in washing powder in the long run!
