Halsford Park Primary School is part of the Everychild Partnership Trust. Our school motto is 'Soaring to Success' because this is what we want our pupils to feel each and every day, in every aspect of their life.

We are a two-form entry school on the north side of the town and enjoy spacious surroundings with well-resourced, bright and airy classrooms in a stimulating and attractive environment. The school has a conservation area and gardens, as well as a polytunnel, outdoor classroom and a range of climbing equipment on an all-weather surface in both playgrounds.

The school is arranged in fourteen classes (two per year group). Early Years classes are in a self-contained unit with their own spacious outdoor learning facility. Key Stage 1/2 classrooms have their own areas within the main school building and their own playgrounds.

Halsford Park had a very successful Ofsted inspection in November 2022 which recognised that our commitment to children's Personal Development is 'Outstanding'. Moreover: "Pupils fully embrace the school's values. These values permeate through all of school life.

An integral part of our school is the resounding commitment to inclusion and raising standards for all pupils. 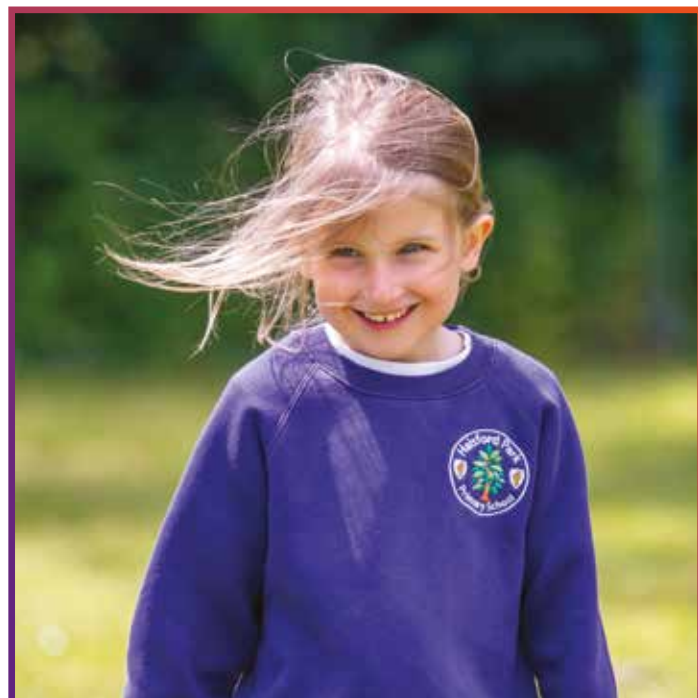

Starting School in Early Years



Halsford Park offers a full programme of initial visits, parent meetings and events designed to make the start of the school process smooth for both pupils and parents which consists of several opportunities to attend more formal afternoon sessions, informal afternoon 'story time' sessions and a morning induction session in the summer term prior to commencement. Family visits take place during the first week of school where the class teacher and teaching assistant will meet with the family either at home or at school.

Through our Early Years' Curriculum the children have the opportunity to explore, build, create, role play, work and play in our outside classroom.

Engaging in an Irresistible Curriculum

From Year 1, children's learning will be focused on the programmes of study set out in the National Curriculum brought together by our thematic 'connected curriculum'. This means the children become

immersed in a particular area of learning for a term and really enjoy the exciting lessons and experiences which are carefully planned by teachers, to make learning as meaningful as possible.

Halsford Park has wonderful grounds which allow outdoor opportunities to enrich learning. We have teachers trained in Forest School type learning and also have a polytunnel where whole classes can undertake a range of educational activities. We also incorporate the science curriculum where children can learn about their local environment.

Learning outdoors encourages working together, resilience, concentration and independence.



Including All Children

Inclusion provision is a very important aspect of our school. We have an in-school support team which is utilised to meet the needs of our children including a team of Support Staff providing a range of additional support where needed.

This is overseen by our full time SENCO. Our aim is to recognise the particular difficulties a child may be experiencing and develop strategies to help provide additional time and support. We work closely together with specialist outside agencies to support learning.



Keeping Your Children Safe



Safeguarding, or keeping your child safe, is one of our prime responsibilities. This includes protection from abuse, online safety, children knowing how to deal with bullying and procedures to keep children safe on off-site visits and more.

In line with legislation, staff, volunteers and contractors are checked for their suitability to work with or near children using the Disclosure and Barring Service and, beyond this, staff and volunteers are fully trained in child protection.
