- 'We are all special just the way we are.'

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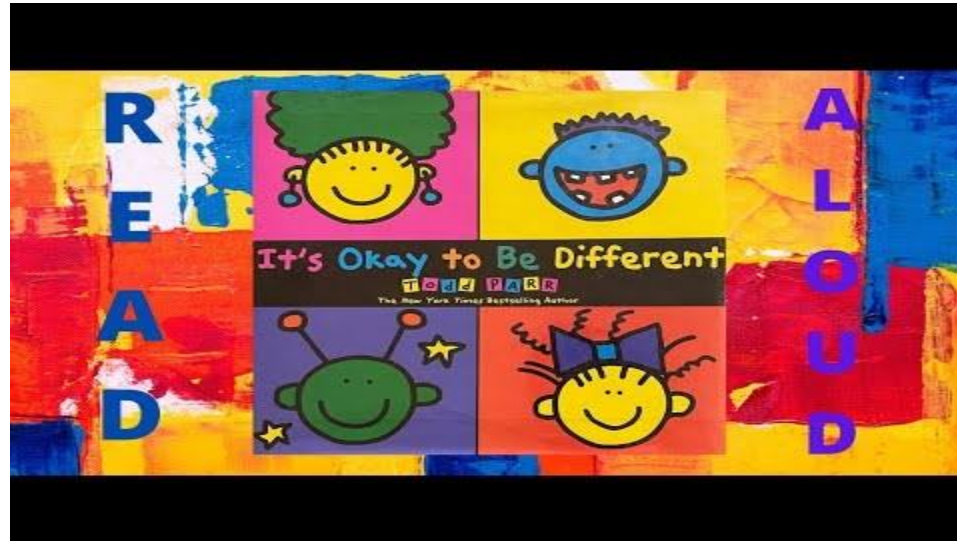


# What Can We Do?
