Attendance and Punctuality

These changes are effective from 1st September with the aim to improve school attendance nationally. The updates include increased fines for unauthorised absence, changes to timescales in which fines can be occurred and for which they can be paid by and the introduction for schools to send 'notices to improve'. As a result, we have updated our Attendance Policy to reflect these changes.
