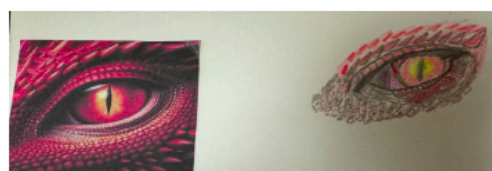
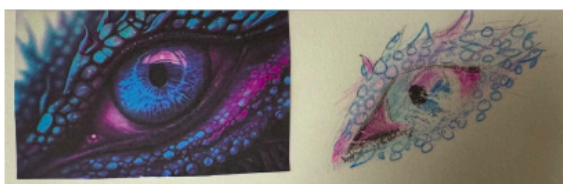
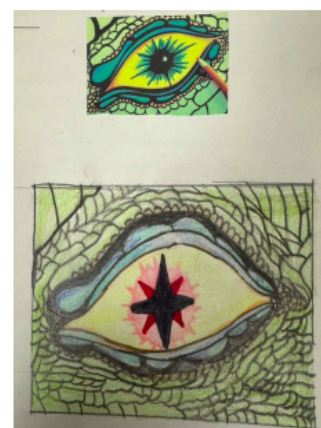


Hatchlands Year 6's showcased their artwork...

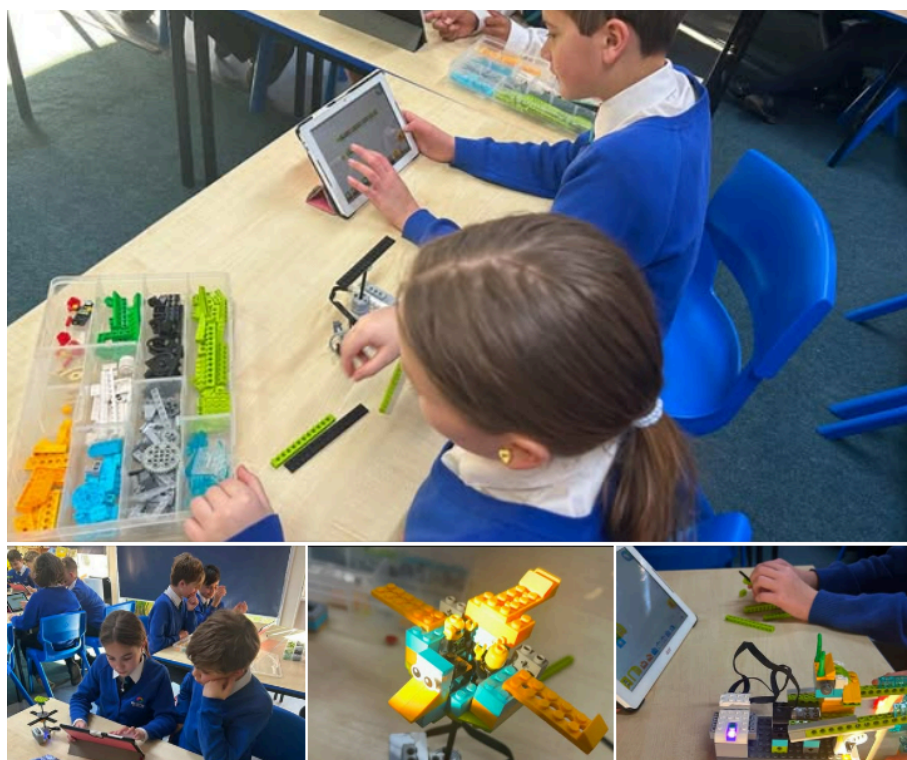
