‘Rainbow Day’ – Friday 27th June 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to share our plans for *Rainbow Day*, which will take place on **Friday 27th June**, as part of our **Diversity Week** celebrations. After the success of the past three years, we are looking forward to another vibrant and meaningful day!

As in previous years, Rainbow Day will help children understand who they can turn to for support and celebrate what makes everyone unique. It also contributes to our ongoing work toward the **Rainbow Flag Award** and aligns closely with our school’s **Core Values**—particularly the importance of respecting others, regardless of sexuality.

Children will take part in a themed assembly, a class activity, and a whole-school art project—all closely linked to our **PSHE curriculum**. The assembly will be led by Colin from **Allsorts Youth Project**, who will talk about why we celebrate Rainbow Day, what it means, and who children can speak to if they have questions. The tone will be positive and age-appropriate, while still touching on important topics such as inclusion, kindness, and addressing bullying and homophobia in a sensitive way.

Class activities will include:

- Year 1: Diverse Families
- Year 2: The Meaning of the Pride Flag
- Year 3: Celebrating Diversity
- Year 4: Challenging Gender Stereotypes
- Year 5: The History of Pride Month
- Year 6: Moving to Secondary School & Your Values

Previous pupil surveys showed how much children enjoy Rainbow Day—especially wearing bright, colourful clothing! On the day, children are invited to wear bright colours or rainbow-themed outfits. There is no charge for this.
