



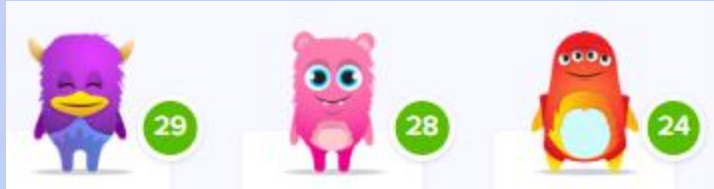
Getting ready for September 2026!

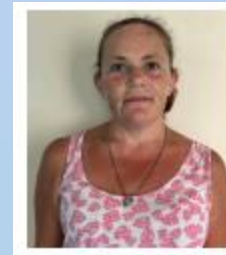

There will be the same adults working in the office.

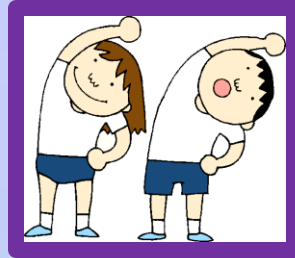


Mrs Brockwell will be in school each day as part of the Mid Day Meals team.

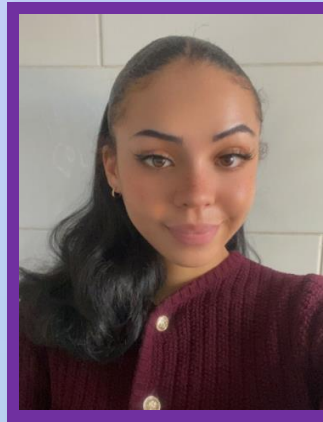

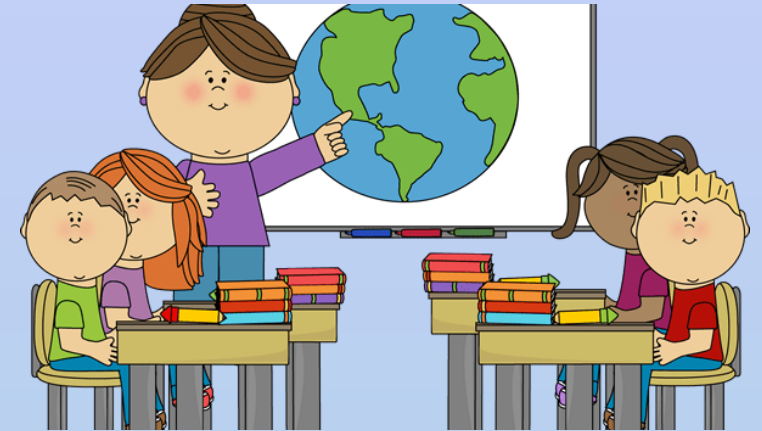




On Wednesday you will spend the afternoon in your new classroom with your new teacher/s and the adults that will be working in that year group.
