Dear Parents and Carers,

'Bikeability' – Monday 10th March – Friday 14th March 2025

We are excited to announce that your child has the opportunity to take part in Bikeability Training in order to enable them to complete Level 1 and 2. The children will need their bikes twice; first on the Level 1 day (Monday) and then again on the day they are allocated for their intensive 1:2 ratio training session. We will inform you prior to the training which day your child has been allocated.

Unfortunately, since September 2021, Bikeability training in West Sussex has moved to a charging model, due to the loss of funding from public health and education. In light of this, the school will subsidise the cost by paying half. This means the cost to parents is £10 per rider.

Please note that safety measures have been put in place and ratios to the course have been changed to adhere to government guidance, and thorough Risk Assessments have been created. The safety of all riders involved in training is the number one priority. However, the syllabus outcomes remain unaltered.

Please check that your child's bike and helmet meets the requirements set out in the Parent/Carer Information letter attached. Requirements can also be found on pages 6 and 7 of The Cycle Right Magazine which can be found here https://www.westsussex.gov.uk/media/11975/cycle_right.pdf.

Your child will need to bring their bike to school on the day of their training and lock it securely in the cycle shed. If your child's lock requires a key, please ensure that it is named and given to the class teacher.
