

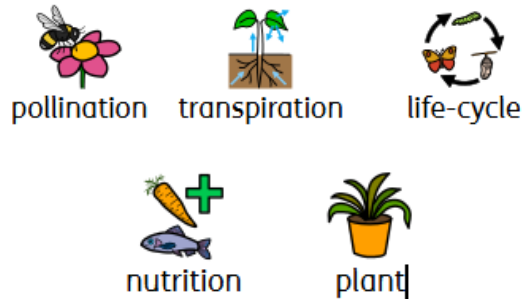


Year 3 Summer Term 1

Science



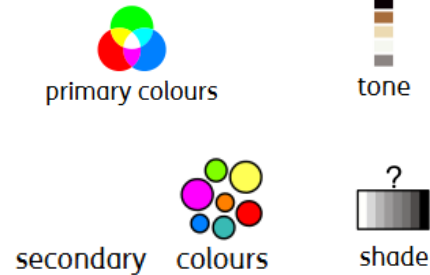
Pollination: the transfer of pollen from one flower to another.

Transpiration: is the evaporation of water at the surfaces of leaves.

Life cycle (plants): The main life cycle stages for a flowering plant are: germination, growth and flowering.

Art

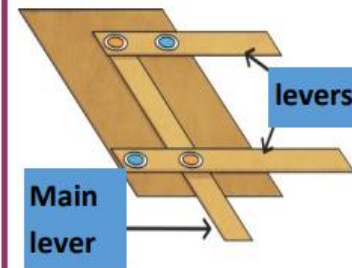


Primary colours: red, yellow and blue.

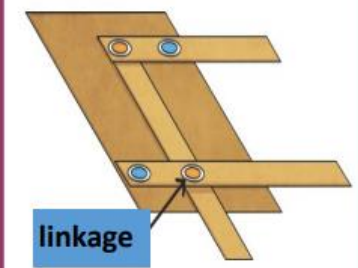
Secondary colours: these colours can be formed by mixing any two primary colours. There are three secondary colours: purple (mixing red and blue); green (mixing blue and yellow); orange (mixing red and yellow).

Design and technology

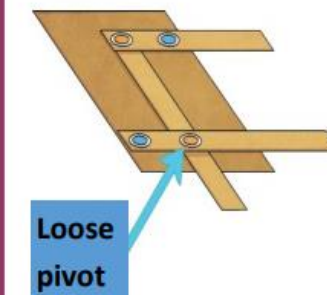
The simplest type of mechanism. A lever is a stiff bar which moves around a pivot.



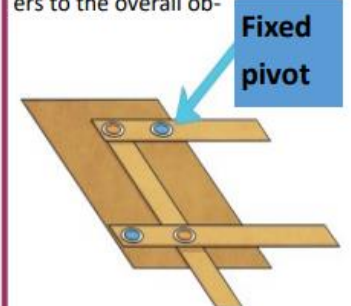
The part of the mechanism used to join one or more levers to produce the type of movement required.



A loose pivot joins the levers together.



A fixed pivot (fulcrum) joins the levers to the overall ob-
