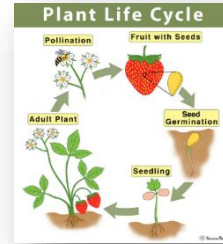
Bug Hunting - We will be taking magnifying glasses outside and identifying the bugs in our school grounds.
