<p><u>Science</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classification - the arrangement of animals and plants in groups. • Organism - an individual animal, plant, or single-celled life form. • Vertebrates - animals with a backbone or spinal column. 	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Geography – the Earth's physical features, processes, and systems • Human Geography - how human activity impacts the environment. • Sustainability - Managing resources so they are not depleted for future generations. 	<p><u>Art</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pop Art - an art movement using popular, commercial imagery, often focusing on everyday items. • Ben-Day Dots - Small coloured dots spaced to create shading or secondary colours. • Screen Printing - A printing technique often used by Andy Warhol to mass-produce images.
