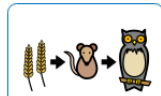
#### Science

**dribbling** – to travel with a ball without holding it

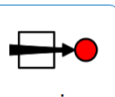
**passing** – throwing a ball between team mates

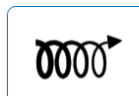

**Artist** A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby



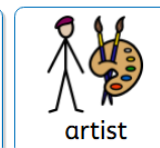

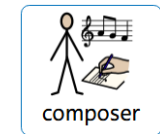
#### Music

**Composer**, A person who writes music, especially as a professional occupation

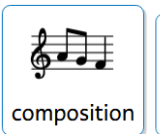
**Composition**, A creative work, especially a poem or piece of music.

**Comparing** Looking at similarities and differences.



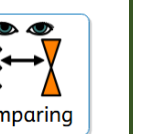

**Delete** – Removes contents such as contents in a cell.

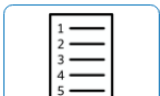
**Data** – A collection of information, used to help answer questions.

**Row** – Boxes running horizontally on a spreadsheet.



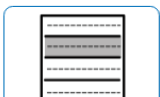

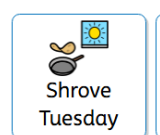
#### RE

**Shrove Tuesday** The day before Ash Wednesday – a day for feasting and celebration.

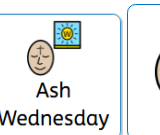
**Ash Wednesday** The first day of Lent.

**Lent** 40 days during which Christians remember the events leading up to and including the death of Jesus Christ.

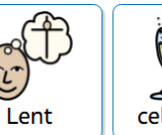
**Celebrate** Acknowledge with a enjoyable activity.



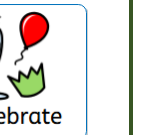
